National Seminar on Conjunctive Use of Surface Water and Groundwater in Major and Medium Irrigation Projects:

The different and complementary characteristics and behavior of surface water and groundwater make it possible to solve specific needs of water quantity and quality more adequately and economically than if both resources were used separately. At present average utilization in major command areas in Andhra Pradesh is of the order 20-25%.
