

Report on Essay Writing Competition on "Role of an Engineer in Society"






Dr.A.Sumalatha, Assistant Professor, Dept. of EIE acted as an evaluator for the competition.














Guest Lecture on "Role of Instrumentation and Control in Solar Power Plant" 19th September 2022




