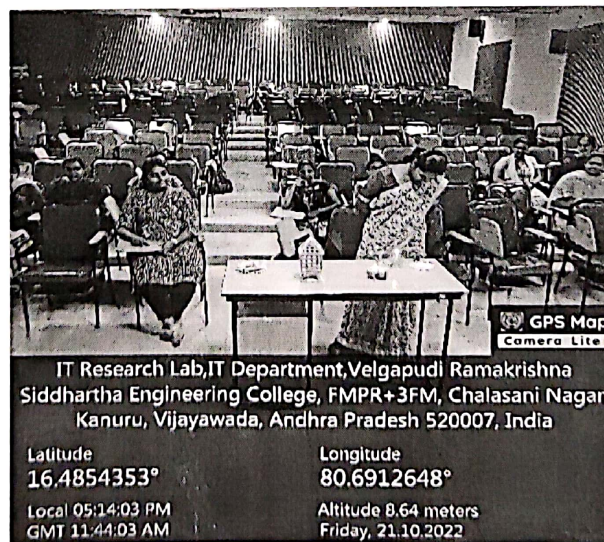
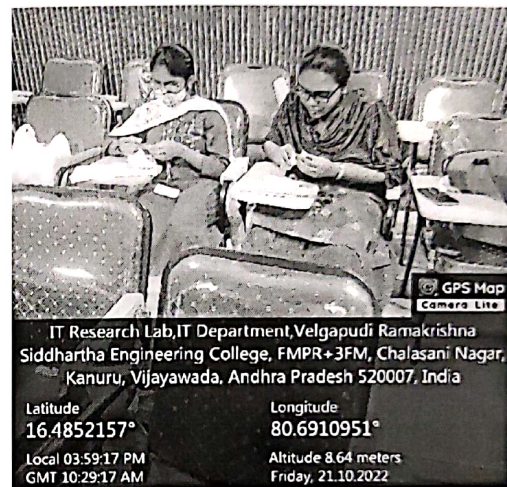
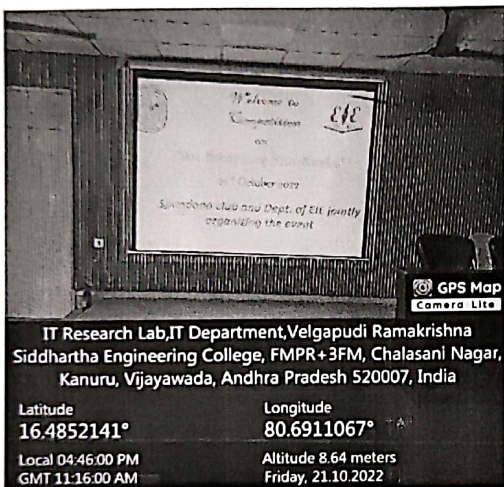


## Report on "Diya Making using Waste Materials " Celebrations

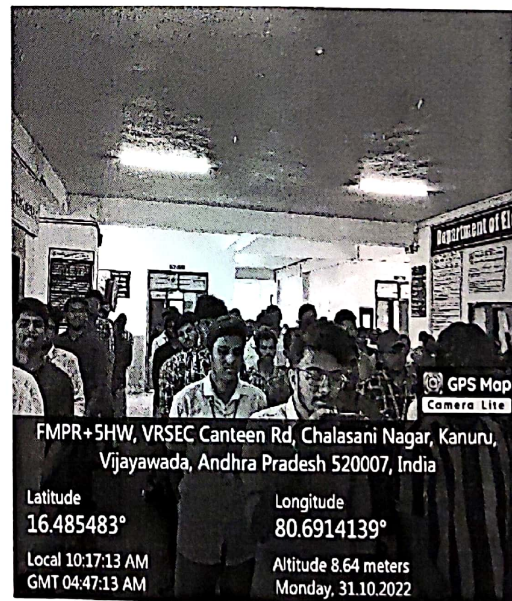
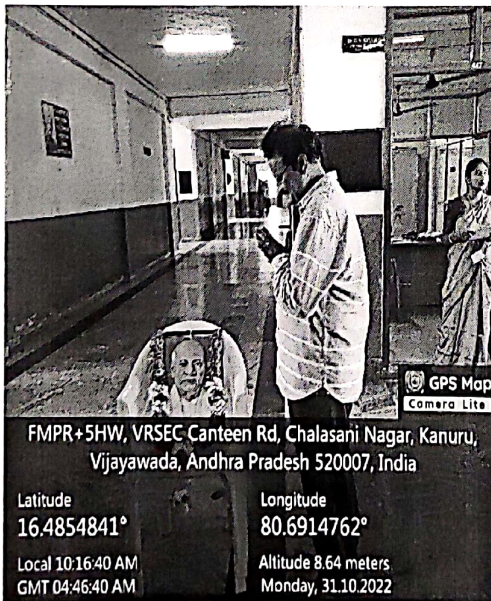
## Report on "National Unity Day" Celebrations
