You need to teach basics of computer how computer works like what is ram what happens when declare a variable what happens when a program is executed like that.

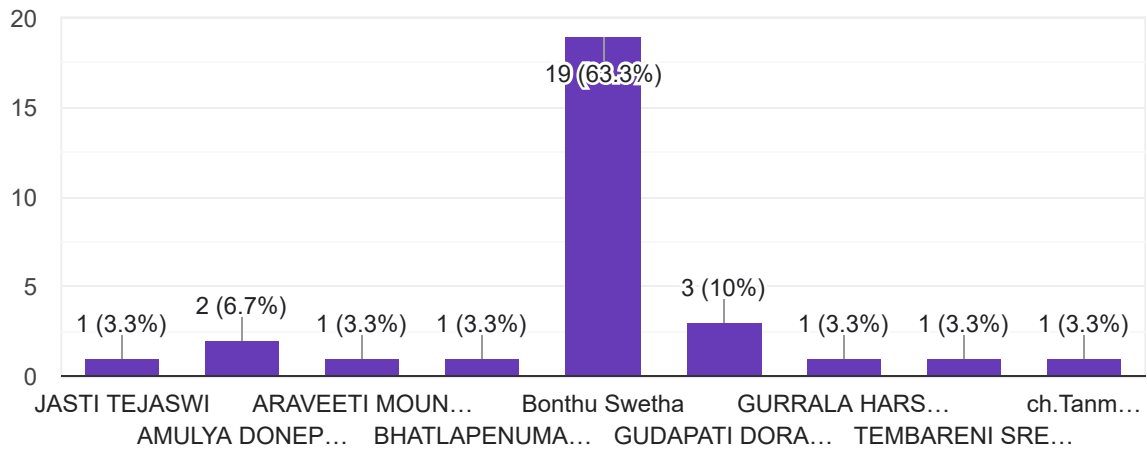
