Two representations were received, one from the Krishna Educational Society, Vijayawada and the other from the Academy of General and Technical Education, Vijayawada, for permission to start an Engineering College at Vijayawada. After examining the request of the both these institutions Government have recommended to the Deputy Educational Adviser (T) Government of India Ministry of Education and Social Welfare, Southern Regional Office at Madras that an Engineering College may be permitted to be started by the Academy of General and Technical Education, at Vijayawada. The Deputy Educational Adviser has been requested to obtain the approval of the Southern Regional Council of the All India Council for Technical Education for starting the College by the Academy.

I am to request you kindly to take the necessary further action about the affiliation of the proposed College to the Nagarjuna University after the Academy makes the request and fulfills all the conditions that are necessary for granting affiliation. The Government is agreeable to the stipulation that no capitation fees should be collected for admission into the College.
