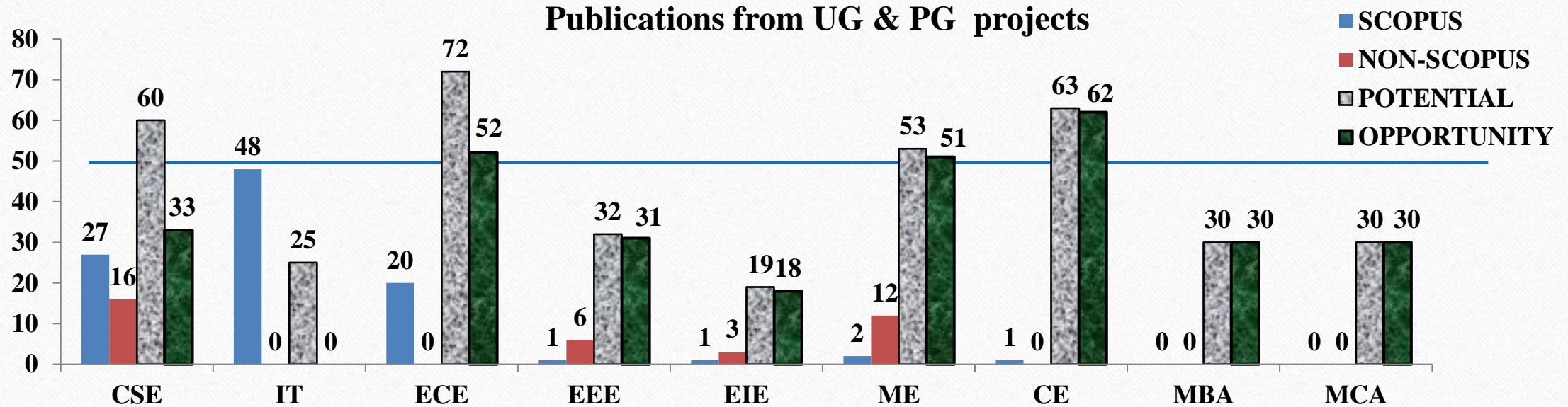

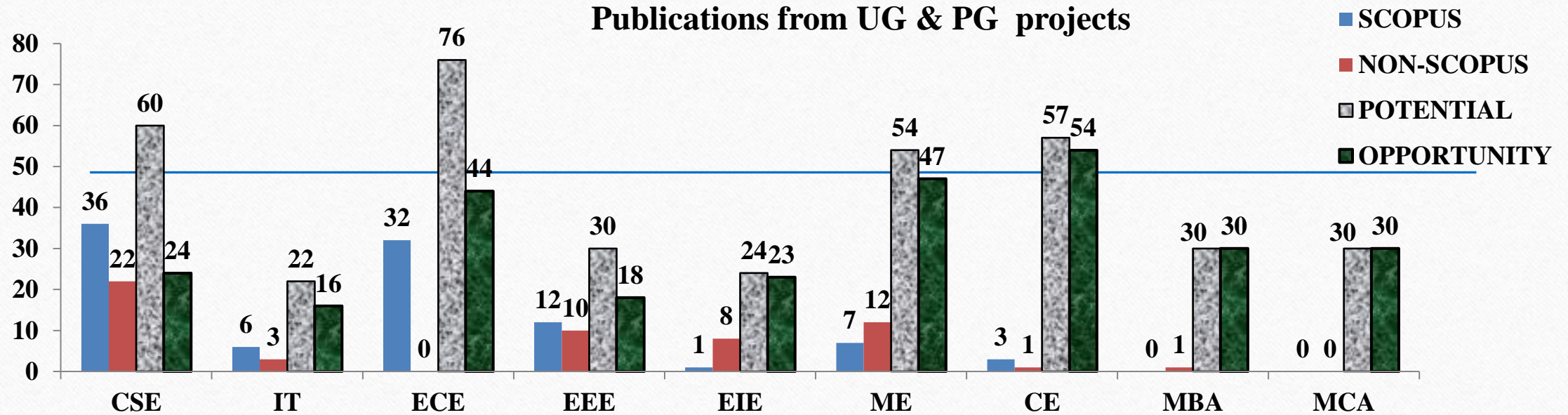

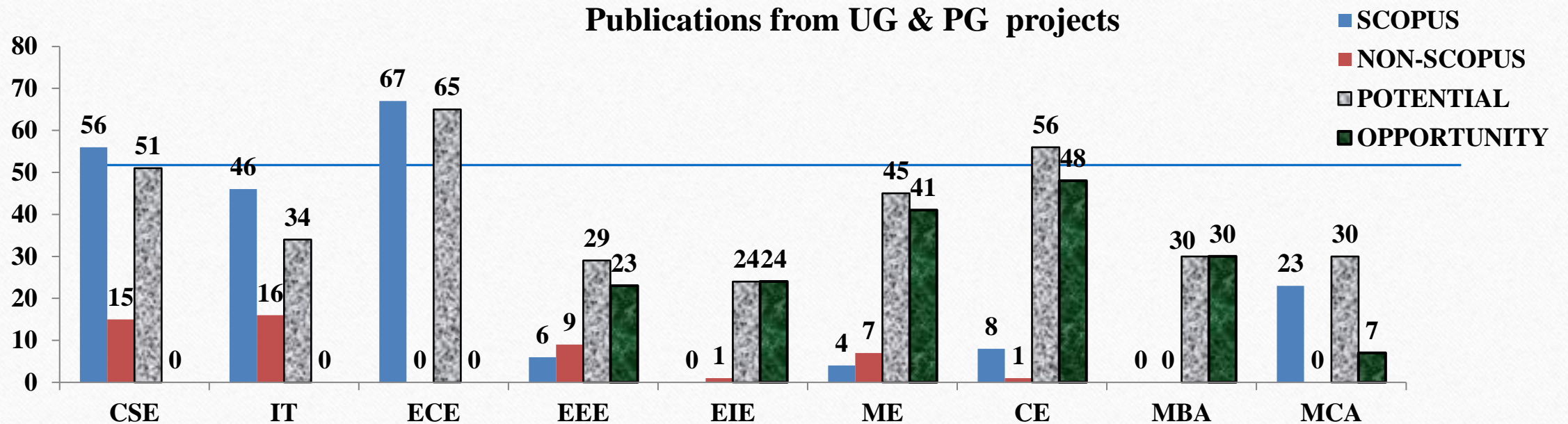

## Recommendations to enhance the quality of student projects for publication

### Opportunity:

As per the VR 20 regulations - 4 categories of projects. 1.EPICS, 2.Mini Project-1, 3.Mini project-2 & 4.Major project.

### Recommendation:

Submission of Detailed Project Proposal (DPP) along with timeline and its possibility of publication, prior to the semester, to the Project Review Committee. Its Scrutinsation and approval with / without modification by the committee.

### Marks Weightage:

Maximum for the Projects published in Scopus indexed journals / WoS / presented in Scopus supported conferences.

### Assessment:

Assessment of progress of the work by the same committee as per VR17 / VR20, two times before final submission, focussing on possibility of its publication.

Note: *The presence of Guide before the committee is mandatory along with students.*

### Corrective Measures:

Guides, who failed to publish min. two out of four projects, have to attend before Dept. level & Institute level R&D committees to identify the reasons for failure and find ways for improvement.



## **B) Issues open for discussion.**

### **1. Streamlining the Student projects emphasizing *Paper publications, Patents, Innovative models development & Start-ups.***

#### **Departments are advised to**

1. identify the students who are active in taking up Innovative projects / patents /Start-ups.  
Encourage them with financial support by allotting suitable faculty, rather than conventional mode of allotment / seniority basis.
2. conduct Idea churning sessions by inviting Industry / Start-up / Alumni experts
3. extend their mini project to major for quality work with ample time and subsequent publication.
4. take necessary steps to involve and work all the students of a batch equally throughout the project as well as at evaluations.
5. take care for meticulous examination on the progress of the project at every assessment.
6. A batch less than 4 students is also allowed, if there is a best outcome. Since fixed no.of students in a batch is not mandatory.

## Encouragement / Appreciation / Recognition of Faculty & Students

### Motivational schemes already in practice to encourage R&D

- a) Training programs on quality publications, patents & start-ups
- b) Seed grant support
- c) Support for attending Workshops / Conferences, both at National & International level
- d) Support for paper publication in Conferences to faculty & students
- e) Financial support to students for Innovative model development & their exhibition.
- f) Financial support for quality project works to students
- g) Financial support to file patents & establish Start-ups
- h) Incentive for quality paper publications.
- i) Incentive for sponsored projects
- j) Appropriate weightage in PBAS

### Further, the IQAC is proposing the following practices to encourage the student publications

1. Certificate of appreciation for students.
2. Display of batches with guide in Institute TVs for a week.
3. Certificate of appreciation for faculty, those who guide not less than two projects and publish them all, in a year.
4. Honoured in an annual event at central level, the faculty those who published all their student projects in two consecutive years.
