**Number of Participants (Total: 120 Students, all teaching staff and non-teaching staff of our department)**

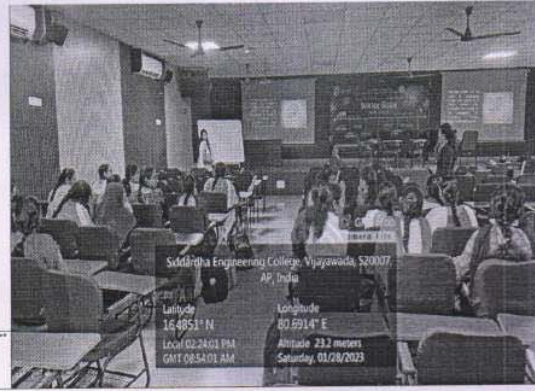
**Seminar Outcome:** Our aim is to provide
