Sri Rajendra Velagapudi, MD & CEO of Cyient DLM, congratulated the team of Siddhartha Engineering College for achieving the status of Deemed to be University and expressed his happiness being part of the alumni of Siddhartha Engineering College.

He asked about monetization of granted patents (earning of money out of selling of patents). Responding to him, Principal informed that so far patents neither sold nor generating money nor commercialized.

He also enquired about the ownership of patents i.e. either by students or institution.

Principal clarified that they are owned by the VRSEC along with the students & staff. He added that some innovations, which are not patented, are commercialized and started generating small revenues to an extent of Rs. 3-4 lakhs and finally Dr Rajendra suggested that try to sell the granted patents and generate money, like several organizations are doing.


Sri. M.Rajayya, Convener of the College and Vice-President, Siddhartha Academy Congratulated Secretary, Principal, Deans who worked and got the Deemed to be University status and wanted to publicize with a big advertisement in newspaper with the permission of Secretary.

Dr. G Yesu Ratnam, JNTUK nominee (Director of IIIP & T and Professor of Civil Engineering at JNTUK, Kakinada), asked why so many students have not taken 'Honours' with twenty credits extra, and asked the seven students registered in CE completed the honours or not.

The Principal responded that all 7 students in CE completed the honours and students are opting more in Minors with same twenty credits, because of its obvious advantage.
