Dr. K. Venkata Reddy, DAP, JNTUK & University nominee suggested to consider CGPA \geq 7.5 for awarding first class with distinction which is being followed by university for the benefit of the students who secure 70% marks in their B.Tech Degree, if we do not consider the students who secured 70% marks may not get distinction grade.

Further, he suggested to encourage more number of students to study minor programmes in addition to their original degree, more flexibility may be given to the students to study inter disciplinary courses to enhance their knowledge, encourage students to go for internships and they should be a real internships rather than virtual.

Item: 7. To consider and approve the proposal for extending the time limit for submitting the **pass certificate of self - learning courses** (NPTEL etc.,) by the students of M.Tech - programme.

Dr. A.V.Ratna Prasad, Principal proposed for extending the time limit for submitting the pass certificate of self - learning courses (NPTEL etc.,) by the students of M.Tech programme because the schedules of NPTEL courses are not matching with the academic calendar of the institution and informed that as per current regulations the students should submit pass certificate of the NPTEL course before the last instruction day of that semester.

- ✓ After discussions the academic council resolved that the students are permitted to submit the pass certificates of the NPTEL courses (MOOCs) on or before the last instruction day of the academic calendar of subsequent semesters. This is applicable from the 2nd year students (2022-23) of the M.Tech (2021-23) batch onwards.
- ✓ Due to the mismatch between the NPTEL examinations and 3rd semester end examinations, some of the 2nd year students (2022-23) of the M.Tech (2021-23) batch could not become eligible for appearing 4th semester final Project work Viva- Voce examination.
- As soon as they submit pass certificate of MOOCs courses of 3rd semester by the end of 4th semester, they are permitted to appear for project work Viva- Voce examination, if they fulfill the other academic regulations in force.

- Item: 8. To consider and approve the proposal for conducting the semesterend supplementary examination with the NPTEL syllabus by the college for the subjects in which candidates appeared and failed in MOOCS (NPTEL) platform.
 - Dr. A.V. Ratna Prasad, Principal expressed the need of **conducting the semester-end supplementary examination with the NPTEL** syllabus by the college for the subjects in which candidates appeared and failed in MOOCS (NPTEL) platform because these subjects may / may not be offered by MOOCS platform in later stages and also time period is mismatching with our academic calendar.
 - ✓ After discussions the Academic Council resolved that the supplementary examinations will be conducted with the NPTEL syllabus by the college for the subjects in which candidates appeared and failed in MOOCS (NPTEL) platform in the M.Tech IV semester and the results will be declared before the commencement of the Project Viva Voce examination. This will be applicable to the students admitted into M.Tech first year from the academic year 2020-21.
- Item: 9. To consider and ratify the admission of Mr. Durga Vivek Surya transferred from PSG Institute of Advanced studies, Coimbatore and to acquire 160 credits for the award of degree as per the G.O. RT No. 83, under VR20 Regulations of VRSEC.
