1. Ms. Nidha Ahmed Mohammad, B.Tech. (Artificial Intelligence & Data Science), secured the highest internship offer of ₹1,50,000 per month from Google.
2. Seventeen students secured internships at Amazon with monthly stipends ranging from ₹1.10 lakh to ₹1.40 lakh, leading to full-time employment offers with an annual package of ₹48 LPA.
3. JP Morgan Chase & Co. offered internships to six students with a monthly stipend of ₹80,000, culminating in full-time job offers with an annual package of ₹19.75 LPA.
