REPORT OF WORKSHOP ON

Research Practice

(Wednesday and Thursday, APRIL 17-18th, 2024)

The workshop was facilitated by Dr. Sanjay Kumar Shukla of Edith Cowan University, Australia, here are the key highlights from a two-day workshop on research practice:

Day 1

- 1. Foundation of Successful Research:
- Emphasize the importance of defining a new problem or addressing a known problem with novel solutions.
- Highlight the significance of understanding research gaps through literature review.
- Stress the need for multidisciplinary collaboration and community/industry engagement.
- 2. Precision in Research Methodologies:
- Discuss the necessity of accuracy and precision in experimental and mathematical works.
- Provide guidelines for ensuring accuracy in measurements and calculations.
- Clarify the distinction between accuracy and precision, and their importance in reliable research outcomes.
- 3. Acknowledging Assumptions and Limitations:
- Stress the importance of acknowledging assumptions and limitations in research.
- Guide researchers on how to prepare a comprehensive list of assumptions and limitations.
- Explain the necessity of discussing these factors in research articles for credibility and recognition.

Day 2

- 4. Mechanistic Understanding and Practical Applications:
- Encourage researchers to explain the mechanisms behind their findings.
- Discuss strategies for developing scientific theories, equations, and design tools for practical applications.
- Provide examples of how understanding mechanisms can enhance the value of research outcomes.

- 5. Comparative Analysis and Critical Discussion:
- Highlight the importance of comparing new findings with existing solutions.
- Guide researchers on how to conduct a critical discussion comparing their work with previous studies.
- Emphasize the need for numerical comparisons to validate the novelty and effectiveness of new approaches.
- 6. Effective Communication and Presentation:
- Discuss strategies for clear and concise communication in research articles.
- Provide guidelines for writing in simple and plain English, avoiding grammatical and presentation errors.
- Stress the importance of professional presentation skills for successful publication.
- 7. Patience and Dedication in Research:
- Emphasize the importance of patience and avoiding rush in the research process.
- Highlight the need for dedication and hard work in achieving practical solutions to real-life problems.
- Encourage researchers to focus on clear conclusions and illustrations for effective field applications.

Throughout the workshop, interactive sessions, case studies, and practical exercises reinforced these key principles and help researchers internalize them for their own research practice. The inclusion of these points enhanced the workshop's content, offering participants, including about 70 Faculty members of VRSEC, a thorough grasp of the practical implications of research within the realm of engineering.

Dr. Rama Vara Prasad Chavali, an Associate Professor of Civil Engineering, coordinated two day workshop focused on enhancing research practices. In addition to overseeing the logistical aspects of the workshops, Dr. Chavali actively contributed to the academic content by delivering the inaugural address, facilitating various sessions, and concluding the event with a vote of thanks.







