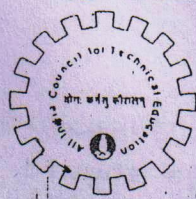

Sir,

I am directed to state that on the basis of the recommendations of the SRC at its meeting held on 9-5-1992 the All India Council for Technical Education has granted approval to V.R. Siddhartha Engineering College Vijaywada, Andhra Pradesh for conduct of the following existing four year degree courses with reduction in intake in Mechanical Engineering from 120 to 60 during the academic year 1993-94:-

1) Civil Engineering	60 (Sixty)
2) Electrical & Electronics Engineering	60 (Sixty)
3) Mechanical Engineering	60 (Sixty)
4) Electronics & Communication Engineering	40 (Forty)
5) Computer Science & Engineering	20 (Twenty)

This approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- 1) The College may submit a proposal immediately for consideration of the AICTE for increase in intake in the existing courses upto the ceiling of 60 per course within the total intake of 300.
- 2) The College should be provided with adequate infrastructural facilities including Library and Laboratory facilities as per the AICTE norms.
- 3) The Management of the College including the Governing Council should be constituted as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- 4) All admissions should be made as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE as adopted by the State of Tamil Nadu.

- 5) The tuition and other fees should be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students/ guardians of the students in any form.
- 6) The accounts of the Institute should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and should be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- 7) Adequate teaching and other staff should be recruited according to the procedure, guidelines and experience prescribed by the AICTE.
- 8) No new course should be started without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- 9) The intake in any of the approved courses should not be altered under any circumstances without the prior concurrence of the AICTE.

This approval is subject to full compliance with the provisions of the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court of India in its Judgment dated 4-2-1993 on Writ Petition (C) No. 607 of 1992.


The Management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Trust or the Institute with the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all the consequent liabilities would be that of the Trust and/or the Institute.


An Expert Committee of the AICTE will visit the College by the end of the academic year 1993-94 to review the progress made in fulfilling the conditions laid down by the AICTE and recommend continuation of the AICTE approval or otherwise.
