#### The following agenda items were discussed and deliberated upon

### 1. To confirm the minutes and report the action taken on the minutes of the previous Academic Council meeting held on 02-02-2019.

Academic Council confirmed the following minutes of the previous meeting and approved the action taken on the minutes of the last meeting held on 02-02-2019

#### Minutes of the previous meeting

- Number of credits to be secured by the students transferred from VR 14 to VR 17 Regulations are 175 for regular & 130 for lateral entry.
- 32 credits -Regular / 00-Lateral Entry for promotion from IV to V semester and 54 credits Regular / 34-Lateral Entry for promotion from VI to VII semester.
- The attendance and marks secured by the students in Mandatory Learning courses during a semester are not counted for detention and for calculation of GPA.
- The attendance and marks secured by the students in one credit course during a semester are not counted for detention. However, the marks secured in these category of courses shall be considered for the calculation of GPA.
- The students pursuing self learning courses through college are required to secure minimum 40% marks (continuous assessment and semester end put together) for qualifying the course.

- scale of punishments for the students who involved in malpractice cases in continuous assessment examination
- Academic Regulations for lateral entry students admitted into MCA course w.e.f. A.Y.2018-2019
- The experts for the Boards of the studies for the period of 3 years w.e.f. A.Y. 2018-2019
- Minutes of the Boards of the studies meetings held in December, 2018.

#### **Action taken report**

- Academic regulations for lateral entry students admitted into MCA course w.e.f. 2018-2019 academic year are implemented.
- Scale of punishments for the students involved in malpractice in continuous assessment examination is implemented.
- Academic experts for the Boards of the studies are nominated for a period of 3 years
- Transitory regulations for the students who joined VR 14 and transferred to VR 17 are implemented.

# 2. To consider and approve the curriculum for B.Tech V & VI semesters to be implemented w.e.f.2019-2020.

Dr.A.V.Ratna Prasad, Principal presented the curriculum for B.Tech V & VI semesters to be implemented w.e.f.2019-2020 before Academic Council.

The Academic Council unanimously approved the curriculum for B.Tech V & VI semesters to be implemented w.e.f.2019-2020 and the said open electives.

# 3. To consider and approve the additional regulation in B.Tech VR17 curriculum w.r.t. open elective subjects to be implemented w.e.f.2019-2020.

Dr.A.V.Ratna Prasad, Principal presented the following amendments/additional regulation in B.Tech VR17 curriculum w.r.t. open elective subjects to be implemented w.e.f.2019-2020.

- **Mandatory Learning Courses:** It is proposed that the student failing to pass in the mandatory learning courses in the first attempt and pass later as supplementary candidate, may also be awarded "Distinction" akin to other students who pass all the courses at first attempt and fulfill the required conditions for award of "**Distinction**".
- **Student Practice Courses:** An activity "Coding Practice" can also be included in 7.2.10 (a) under Co- curricular participation.

#### Open Electives:-

- At present two open electives are given provision to pursue through MOOCs.
- Proposed to permit the remaining three open elective courses also on MOOCs mode, based on the recommendation of the HOD's.

- If the student wish to undergo relevant course under open elective in 3<sup>rd</sup> B.Tech the following subjects shall be offered.
  - > Artificial Intelligence
  - Machine Learning
  - > Python Programming
- If a student fails to pass the chosen course approved by the department under MOOCs platform and the same course is not available in the subsequent semester/year, he/she may be permitted to choose another course under MOOCs as approved by the department, in 7.2.2
- It is resolved to approve the additional regulation/amendments in B.Tech VR17 Curriculum to be implemented w.e.f.2019-2020.
