QUESTION PAPER QUALITY

- 1. Collection of Syllabus and Model Papers with the Signatures of Faculty members and HODs
- 2. Selection of Paper Setters from Approved Panel
- Examiners are identified based on the qualification, experience, reputation of the Institution
- 3. Dispatch of Material for Paper Setting
- Model Question Paper & Syllabus Copy along with instructions
- 4. Paper Receiving within a Stipulated Time
- 5. Depositing in Question Paper Bank under safe custody
- Multiple sets of Question Papers from different examiners for each subject are procured

QUESTION PAPER QUALITY

6. Selection of a Set from Question Bank

X At the time of examinations, Question papers are selected at random from the available sets

7.DTP work only after Coding of Question Paper

× A specific code is given to each of the subjects without mentioning the title

8. Scrutiny of Question Paper

- × After type setting, the papers are referred to the senior teachers drawn from various departments for scrutiny who are identified with prior approval of the Principal
- × The Scrutinizer checks the Question Paper thoroughly
- × Out of Syllabus questions are replaced by suitable questions within the syllabus
- **×** Data insufficiency is corrected
- × Mere repetition of Questions from Model papers and previous Question Papers is minimized

QUESTION PAPER QUALITY

9. Decoding and Final Preparation of Manuscript with Title

 After the exercise of scrutiny, the papers once again type set including the subject titles – Master copy is prepared

10. Printing Work

× Based on the question paper requirement received from the examination section, multiple copies of the question paper are prepared using internal confidential printing system

11.Question papers in Bundles of TEN/TWENTY in Sealed Covers

★ Sealed covers will be handed over to the examination section — a day before the commencement of end semester examinations

REVALUATION SYSTEM

- The students can submit applications for revaluation in response to the notification issued by CoE along with stipulated fee if he/she is not satisfied with marks obtained in Theory Courses or he/she is not successful in theory courses
- × The scripts are arranged for revaluation by identifying an external examiner other than original examiner
- × The result of revaluation is announced within 40 days from the date of preparation of List of Students Applied for Revaluation
- × 50% of the revaluation fee is refunded to the candidate if he/she is benefitted on revaluation to the extent of more than 10% of the maximum marks



About Examination Section

- Starts from Examination Registration to packing of Answer Scripts to Confidential Section of Institute
- Conducts the semester end examinations
 - As per the academic regulations & calendar of Institute
 - 170 days are meant for conducting the Theory examinations in a year which includes
 - UG: 8 Semesters(odd and even semester)
 - PG: 4 Semesters (MBA, MCA and M.Tech.)

Examination Fee notification and particulars

- Notification is issued by CoE one month prior to the commencement of the examinations
- Paid through bank challan
- A copy of the fee challan and examination registration form will be submitted

Time tables

- Time tables are issued by the CoE
- Issued two weeks prior to the commencement
- Displayed at various locations
 - Examination Section
 - Departmental Notice boards
 - Institute Website

Man power and seating arrangement

- For every 20 candidates 1 invigilator is assigned
 - with a maximum of 2 invigilators
 - An average of 70 invigilators are assigned on a day of examination(UG)
- The list of invigilators will be given by the respective HoD's on request
- The seating arrangement
 - Jumbling system with 4 branches of student
 - The distance between two candidates is 1.5mts apart

Squad and observers

- Appointed by the Principal in Consultation with the Deputy CoE
- 1 observer for every 300 students
- Includes External and Internal
 - External Observers are drawn from the near by Govt.
 Colleges
 - Internal Observers are drawn from the senior faculty of the Institute
- Go through all the examination halls to check for unfair means

Malpractice cases and punishments

- A Malpractice Enquiry Committee (MEC) is constituted to review the malpractice case booked by the Squad/Observer/Invigilator
- Malpractice Material consists of mainly Micro Xerox and Hand written
- Proceedings of Malpractice booked:
 - Explanation from the suspected student
 - Written complaint from invigilator and observer
 - The malpractice material is sealed and sent to the CoE through Principal
 - Punishments are imposed for such candidates as per the rules prescribed
