Action plan to complete the remaining syllabus

a) Syllabus coverage:

1. By the time of COVID19 lockdown

2nd/3rd/4th year B.Tech / M. Tech / MCA/ MBA - 75 % to 85%

1st B.Tech /MBA / MCA / M. Tech – 50 to 60% of syllabus was covered

2. Completion of the rest of syllabus by 31st May 2020 through online classes utilizing digital platforms such as Google Meet, Cisco WebEx, Zoom, etc.

Action plan to complete the remaining syllabus

- 3. Training sessions (online) to all the faculty to train them in 'online teaching through digital platforms' by CSE & IT departments.**
- 4. Instructions to all the Heads to circulate the class wise schedule to all students in advance and ensure above 90% of students attendance.**

b) (Continuous evaluation) Internal examinations

Second midterm examinations are pending for II, III and IV B Tech/MBA/MCA courses.

Completion of the examinations using the MOODLE platform, before middle of June 2020.

Regarding continuous evaluation of few laboratory courses left, directions to all the Heads to complete them through online interactions, where the evaluation is yet to be done.

2) Action plan to engage the faculty and students effectively during Lockdown through online courses

Utilisation of the Lockdown situation effectively by registering online courses for advancement of knowledge and keeping the following points in mind.

- a) They have to enhance the emerging skills required for the current industry for better employment and opportunities in higher education to students.**
