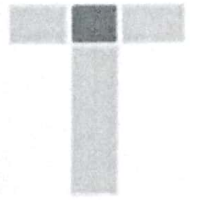

IDEATHON

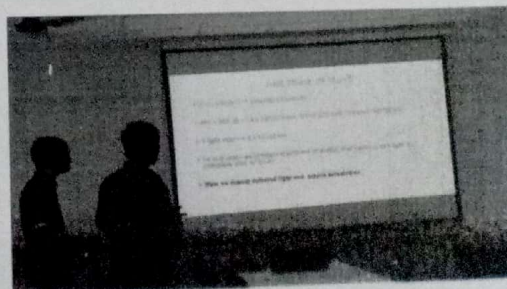
The competition is designed for students to display their ideas. Ideas are the only one which can't be bought. Here is the great platform for the students to expose their ideas and get suggestions from the Judges.

Total 3 teams participated in this event. Finally, one team had given the Prize.

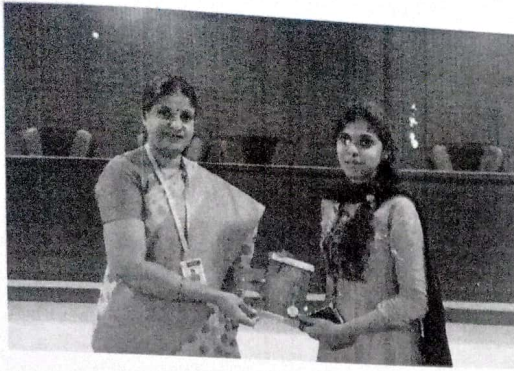


BEST OUT OF WASTE
